Your generosity ensures that The Lighthouse can continue to meet the needs of those who come through our doors.












Giving Back: Clothing Pop-Ups & Holiday Food Bank Hampers



We are deeply grateful for the generosity we experienced again in 2024 to help keep our programs running, whether through financial contributions, food donations or gifts of clothing. The Lighthouse has been blessed by the generous giving of so many! We are also



blessed because of the dedicated staff, volunteers and placement students who each week make our programs a success for our clients. Throughout another year we have seen how the Lord continues to use The Lighthouse to fulfill His calling to serve and love our neighbour.

The new year also gets us to look at the challenges we encountered the past year. Challenges around staffing, having enough board members, financial matters, the structure of the building and having enough volunteers and placement students.
